Waste Management ♦ Clean Up

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— INSIDE HIGHLIGHTS —

After selecting 12 small businesses for national Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity cleanup contracts last week, the award of a parallel set of unrestricted ID/IQ contracts is “forecast for within the next month,” DOE spokesman Bill Taylor said late last week. 2

Industry officials got their first look at DOE’s plans for the next cleanup contract for the West Valley Demonstration Project last week, with DOE issuing a draft Request for Proposals for comment. 3

A recently completed review of the cleanup of Los Alamos has called for further study of possibly separating out cleanup work at the lab for a separate contract. 3

The DOE Office of Environmental Management is upping its already ambitious estimate for how much cleanup work can be performed at the Savannah River Site with Recovery Act funds 4

Los Alamos National Laboratory has been forced to look for a new approach to developing a replacement liquid radioactive waste processing capability due to escalating costs on the project to date. 5
